**Tree types:** standard trees, feathered trees, conifers | **Topiary on stem:** globe | **Topiary:** beehive, globe

### USE

**Location:** park, central reservation, large garden, small garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant

**Crown shape:** pyramidal | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 8 - 15 m | **Width:** 4 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 8B

### ASPECTS

**Wind:** tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic | **Host plant/forage plant:** birds, owls, small mammals

**Flowers:** discrete | **Flower colour:** red-violet, blue-violet, yellow-green | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** dark green, underside white-grey | **Leaves:** evergreen, needles or scales | **Fruits:** striking, large, cones | **Fruit colour:** red-violet, blue-violet | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth, later on rough | **Twig colour:** grey | **Twigs:** horizontal branches, finely branched, short shoots | **Root system:** shallow
