TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, shade trees, characteristic trees | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: avenue, square, park, central reservation, in containers, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 8 - 10 m | **Width:** 6 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6B - 9A

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution, tolerates heat

Flowers: corymbose, standing | **Flower colour:** yellow-green | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** buds bronze, green | **Leaves:** deciduous, polished, lobate | **Autumn colour:** orange-red | **Fruits:** striking, winged | **Fruit colour:** brown-green | **Bark colour:** orange, grey | **Bark:** peeling | **Twig colour:** brown | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** shallow, slightly branched
