Tree types: standard trees

USE

Location: street, avenue, square, park, central reservation, roof garden, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: columnar, egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 20 - 25 m | **Width:** 6 - 10 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline (5.6 - 8.2) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

Flowers: corymbose, pendulous | **Flower colour:** yellow-green | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, palmate, lacinate, serrate | **Autumn colour:** golden yellow | **Fruits:** striking, winged | **Fruit colour:** brown-green | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** smooth, later on rough | **Twig colour:** grey-green | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** deep, highly branched, fine roots
