TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, feathered trees, multi-stemmed trees, climate trees, shade trees | **Topiary on stem:** block, multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: street, avenue, square, park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts:** Climate planting, Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 12 - 17 m | **Width:** 9 - 12 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution, tolerates heat

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: corymbose, discrete | **Flower colour:** yellow-green | **Flowering period:** March - April | **Leaf colour:** buds bronze, bright green, underside grey-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, palmate, thick, opposite, doubly serrate, lobate | **Autumn colour:** orange-red, scarlet | **Fruits:** rarely fruits, winged | **Fruit colour:** yellow-brown, green | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** striped, with lenticels | **Root system:** deep, shallow, fine roots
