Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 6 - 10 m | **Width:** 6 - 10 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies | **Extreme environments:** curiosity

Flowers: spikes, striking, standing, pendulous | **Flower colour:** yellow-green | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** buds violet, blue-green, underside pale green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, opposite, dentate, composite, ternate | **Autumn colour:** orange, orange-red, red | **Fruits:** striking, winged, large | **Fruit colour:** red-brown, pale grey | **Bark colour:** pale grey | **Bark:** slightly furrowed, striped | **Twig colour:** green, grey-blue | **Twigs:** hairy, frosty, horizontal branches, pendulous, finely branched | **Root system:** shallow
