Tree types: multi-stemmed trees, characteristic trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, in containers, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

Crown shape: vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 3 - 5 m | **Width:** 3 - 5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist, wet | **Light requirements:** partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral (6.1 - 7.5) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 1, pollen value 1

Flowers: corymbose, discrete, pendulous | **Flower colour:** red | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** red-brown, red, buds red-violet | **Leaves:** deciduous, palmate, opposite, dissected, lacinate, serrate | **Autumn colour:** scarlet | **Fruits:** discrete, winged | **Fruit colour:** brown, brown-green, green | **Bark colour:** brown, grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** red | **Twigs:** bare, pendulous | **Root system:** shallow, fine roots
