TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: multi-stemmed trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, in containers, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 4.5 - 6 m | **Width:** 5 - 7 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral (6.1 - 7.8) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 1, pollen value 1

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: corymbose, striking, pendulous, small | **Flower colour:** red | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** buds red, dark red-violet | **Leaves:** deciduous, palmate, opposite, dentate, lobate | **Autumn colour:** dark red | **Fruits:** striking, winged, small | **Fruit colour:** red | **Bark colour:** brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** brown-violet | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** shallow, compact, many hair roots, fine roots
