USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: flattened spherical | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 2 - 3 m | **Width:** 2 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist, wet | **Light requirements:** partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral (6.1 - 7.5) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 1, pollen value 1

Flowers: raceme, striking, pendulous | **Flower colour:** red | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** buds red, bronze-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, palmate, opposite, lacinate, serrate | **Autumn colour:** scarlet | **Fruits:** striking, winged | **Fruit colour:** violet | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** grey-brown | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** shallow, fine roots
