



TYPES OF PLANTING Tree types: solitary shrubs

USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | Pavement: none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: flattened spherical | Crown structure: semi-open | Height: 2 - 3 m | Width: 2 - 3 m | Winter hardiness zone: 6A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | Soil: loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | Nutrient level: moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | Soil moisture level: dry, moist | Light requirements: sun, partial shade | pH range: acidic, neutral (5.1 - 7.5) | Host plant/forage plant: bees, nectar value 1, pollen value 1

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: corymbose, discrete, small | Flower colour: violet | Flowering period: May - June | Leaf colour: yellow-green, buds red | Leaves: deciduous, palmate, opposite, laciniate, serrate, lobate | Autumn colour: scarlet | Fruits: discrete, winged | Fruit colour: red-violet | Bark colour: green | Bark: smooth | Twig colour: red | Twigs: bare | Root system: shallow, fine roots
