TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: half-stem trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: flattened spherical | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 2 - 3 m | **Width:** 2 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral (5.1 - 7.5) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 1, pollen value 1

Flowers: corymbose, discrete | **Flower colour:** red | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, palmate, dissected, lacinate, serrate, lobate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-orange | **Fruits:** discrete, winged, small | **Fruit colour:** red-violet | **Bark colour:** brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** brown-green | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** shallow, many hair roots, fine roots
