Tree types: half-stem trees, multi-stemmed trees, solitary shrubs

USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 4 - 6 m | **Width:** 2 - 4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral (6.1 - 7.5) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 1, pollen value 1

Flowers: corymbose, discrete, pendulous | **Flower colour:** dark red | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** buds bronze, green | **Leaves:** deciduous, palmate, leathery, dissected, serrate | **Autumn colour:** scarlet | **Fruits:** discrete, winged | **Fruit colour:** red | **Bark colour:** brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** shallow, fine roots
