Location: park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none, open

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide oval | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 10 - 12 m | **Width:** 6 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4B - 9A

ASPECTS

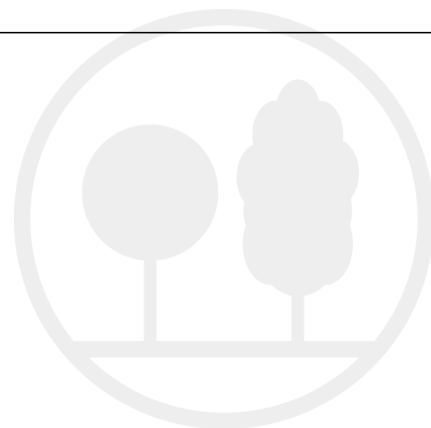
Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds, small mammals, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution, tolerates heat

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: corymbose, striking, pendulous | **Flower colour:** bright yellow | **Flowering period:** April - April | **Leaf colour:** yellow, buds yellow, yellow-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, palmate, big, opposite, dentate | **Autumn colour:** dark yellow, yellow-orange | **Fruits:** striking, winged | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth, later on rough | **Twig colour:** pale brown | **Twigs:** bare, vertical branches, thickly branched, long shoots | **Root system:** deep, shallow, fine roots, central root
