Location: avenue, park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none, open | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: ovoid | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 8 - 15 m | **Width:** 8 - 12 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral (5.1 - 7.0) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, nectar value 5, pollen value 5

Flowers: corymbose, discrete, small | **Flower colour:** red | **Flowering period:** March - April | **Leaf colour:** buds red, green, underside blue-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, palmate, opposite, lacinate, serrate | **Autumn colour:** red, red-violet | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** deep, slightly branched, central root
