Location: park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Landscape planting, urban planting

Crown shape: flattened spherical | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 5 - 7 m | **Width:** 5 - 7 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 7B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, birds, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution

Flowers: umbels, standing, flower-scented | **Flower colour:** cream-white | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** buds bronze, dark green | **Leaves:** deciduous, opposite, leathery, polished, doubly serrate, lobate | **Autumn colour:** yellow, orange, orange-red, red | **Fruits:** striking, winged | **Fruit colour:** red | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** red | **Twigs:** bare, long shoots | **Root system:** shallow, fine roots
