Tree types: standard trees

USE

Location: street, avenue, park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded, ovoid | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 12 - 15 m | **Width:** 12 - 14 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9A

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds, small mammals, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | **Extreme environments:** no infection with bleeding canker, no infestation by horse-chestnut leaf miner

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: panicle, striking, standing, flower-scented | **Flower colour:** yellow-green | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** dark green, underside pale green | **Leaves:** deciduous, obovate, ovoid, palmate, big, opposite, matt polished, doubly serrate, composite | **Autumn colour:** orange-red, red-brown | **Fruits:** toxic, nut, husk | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth, later on rough | **Twig colour:** grey-brown, red, green | **Twigs:** bare, with lenticels, pendulous, thickly branched | **Root system:** extensive, coarse roots
