



TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, climate trees, shade trees

USE

Location: avenue, park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside | **Pavement**: none, open | **Planting concepts**: Climate planting, Eco planting, Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded, ovoid | Crown structure: dense | Height: 15 - 20 m | Width: 10 - 15 m | Winter hardiness zone: 6A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | Soil: loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | Nutrient level: moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | Soil moisture level: dry, moist | Light requirements: sun, partial shade | pH range: acidic, neutral, alkaline | Host plant/forage plant: bees, butterflies, birds, small mammals, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | Extreme environments: tolerant to dryness, tolerates heat

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: panicle, striking, standing, big | Flower colour: pink-red | Flowering period: May - May | Leaf colour: dark green | Leaves: deciduous, palmate, big, opposite, polished, composite, wrinkled | Autumn colour: yellow-brown | Fruits: rarely fruits, capsule, husk | Fruit colour: green | Bark colour: grey-brown | Bark: slightly furrowed | Twig colour: grey | Twigs: bare | Root system: deep, highly branched, fine roots, tap root
