Location: avenue, park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none, open | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide oval | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 12 - 15 m | **Width:** 8 - 12 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 5, pollen value 5

Flowers: panicle, striking, standing, big, weakly scented | **Flower colour:** daffodil, pink | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** dark green, underside pale green | **Leaves:** deciduous, palmate, big, polished, underside hairy, composite | **Autumn colour:** yellow-brown | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** brown | **Twigs:** bare, with lenticels | **Root system:** deep, highly branched, central root
