USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none, open

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: pyramidal | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 6 - 8 m | **Width:** 5 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline (5.1 - 8.2) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: panicle, standing, stuffed, small | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** deciduous, palmate, narrow, dissected, serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-brown | **Fruits:** rarely fruits, capsule, husk | **Fruit colour:** green | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth, later on rough | **Twig colour:** brown | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** deep, highly branched, central root
