Location: street, avenue, square, park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting, Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: pyramidal | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 10 - 15 m | **Width:** 4 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, small mammals, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness

Flowers: panicle, striking, big, scented | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** deciduous, obovate, big, opposite, composite | **Autumn colour:** yellow-brown | **Fruits:** striking, large, husk | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** brown | **Bark:** peeling, smooth, later on rough | **Twig colour:** grey-brown, dark grey | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** deep, shallow, extensive, highly branched, central root
