Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees

USE

Location: street, avenue, square, park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting, Landscape planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded, ovoid | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 12 - 18 m | **Width:** 10 - 15 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 7B - 9A

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, small mammals | **Extreme environments:** no infection with bleeding canker

Flowers: panicle, striking, standing, big | **Flower colour:** white, red | **Flowering period:** June - July | **Leaf colour:** dark green, underside grey-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, big, thick, leathery, polished, serrate, composite, lobate | **Autumn colour:** orange | **Fruits:** striking, large, husk | **Fruit colour:** green | **Bark colour:** grey-green | **Bark:** slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** brown-green | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** shallow, highly branched
