**Tree types:** half-stem trees | **Topiary on stem:** globe

### USE

**Location:** park, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed

### CHARACTERISTICS

**Crown shape:** rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 3 - 4 m | **Width:** 2 - 4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 9B

### ASPECTS

**Wind:** tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral (6.1 - 7.5) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies

**Flowers:** panicle, striking, standing | **Flower colour:** yellow-pink, salmon pink | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** blue-green, underside pale green | **Leaves:** deciduous, obovate, underside hairy, serrate, composite | **Autumn colour:** yellow-orange | **Fruits:** rarely fruits, husk | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** brown | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** deep, shallow, extensive, central root
