Tree types: half-stem trees

USE

Location: park, in containers, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 4 - 6 m | **Width:** 2 - 4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline (6.1 - 7.8) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: panicle, striking, pendulous, big | **Flower colour:** yellow-red | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** buds bronze, blue-green, underside pale green | **Leaves:** deciduous, obovate, matt polished, underside hairy, serrate, composite | **Autumn colour:** yellow, red | **Fruits:** rarely fruits, husk | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** brown | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** deep, shallow, extensive, central root
