TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: flattened spherical | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 2 - 4 m | **Width:** 4 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6B - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, nectar value 4, pollen value 4 | **Extreme environments:** tolerates heat

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: panicle, standing, big | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** July - August | **Leaf colour:** buds red, dark green, underside felty white | **Leaves:** deciduous, palmate, underside hairy, composite | **Autumn colour:** pale yellow | **Fruits:** rarely fruits, husk | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** grey-brown | **Twigs:** bare, with lenticels | **Root system:** shallow, fine roots, root suckers
