USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, countryside | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting, Landscape planting, shade-tolerant

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 10 - 15 m | **Width:** 6 - 10 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6B - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, small mammals | **Extreme environments:** no infection with bleeding canker

Flowers: panicle, striking, standing | **Flower colour:** dark red | **Flowering period:** June - June | **Leaf colour:** buds orange-red, pale green | **Leaves:** deciduous, obovate, big, opposite, doubly serrate, composite | **Autumn colour:** yellow-brown, orange | **Fruits:** striking, husk | **Fruit colour:** pale brown | **Bark colour:** brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** brown | **Twigs:** hairy | **Root system:** extensive, fine roots, coarse roots, tap root
