**Tree types:** half-stem trees

### USE

**Location:** park, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio | **Pavement:** none

### CHARACTERISTICS

**Crown shape:** rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 2 - 3 m | **Width:** 2 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6B - 9B

### ASPECTS

**Wind:** intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral (6.1 - 7.5) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees | **Extreme environments:** no infection with bleeding canker

**Flowers:** panicle, standing | **Flower colour:** salmon pink | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** buds bronze, pale green | **Leaves:** deciduous, palmate, composite | **Autumn colour:** golden yellow | **Fruits:** large, husk | **Fruit colour:** brown-green | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** grey-brown | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** extensive, fine roots, coarse roots, tap root
