Location: park, central reservation, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 4 - 7 m | **Width:** 4 - 5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 7A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds

Flowers: panicle, striking, standing, big, scented | **Flower colour:** pink-red | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** buds bronze, dark green, underside yellow-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, palmate, big, serrate | **Autumn colour:** pale yellow | **Fruits:** rarely fruits, husk | **Fruit colour:** pale brown | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** brown-green | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** extensive, fine roots
