
Amelanchier laevis 'R.J. Hilton' Allegheny serviceberry 'R.J. Hilton'



Amelanchier laevis 'R.J. Hilton' (Allegheny serviceberry 'R.J. Hilton') is a natural selection of the Amelanchier laevis. For five years, plant collectors searched Nova Scotia and Newfoundland in Canada for seedlings of the Amelanchier laevis, which had unique properties. The 'R.J. Hilton' cultivar comes from the first group of selections, planted in 1985 at the Agriculture Canada Research Station in Kentville.

The 'R.J. Hilton' selection has a narrow, upright vase-shaped habit. The shrub blooms in April and May with big pink buds, from which white, star-shaped flowers appear. The budding leaves are deep bronze-red, dark-green in summer and yellow-orange-red in autumn.

For the best bloom, fruit production and autumn colours, the shrub should be planted in the sun and in slightly acidic, permeable, humous and moist soil. The *Amelanchier laevis* 'R.J. Hilton' can tolerate strong wind and air pollution well and the shrub is winter-hardy. It is a great species for use in gardens and parks, but definitely also for roof gardens and containers.
