



TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: multi-stemmed trees, solitary shrubs | Other types of planting: undergrowth

USE

Location: park, central reservation, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside | **Pavement**: none | **Planting concepts**: Landscape planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded, wide egg-shaped | Crown structure: semi-open | Height: 1 - 3 m | Width: 2 - 3 m | Winter hardiness zone: 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | Soil: loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | Nutrient level: moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | Soil moisture level: dry, moist | Light requirements: sun, partial shade | pH range: acidic, neutral, alkaline (6.2 - 8.2) | Host plant/forage plant: bees, butterflies, birds | Extreme environments: tolerates air pollution, tolerates heat

Flowers: raceme, standing | Flower colour: cream-white | Flowering period: May - May | Leaf colour: silvery white emerging leaves, dark green, grey-green, underside blue-green | Leaves: deciduous, obovate, serrate | Autumn colour: orange-red | Fruits: edible, berry | Fruit colour: blue, blue-black, black | Bark colour: grey-brown | Bark: smooth | Twig colour: olive green | Twigs: hairy, bare | Root system: shallow, extensive, slightly branched, central root,
