Tree types: fruit trees, solitary shrubs

USE

Location: park, central reservation, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, ecological zone | **Pavement:** none, open

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: egg-shaped, narrow egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 2 - 3 m | **Width:** 2 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline (5.6 - 7.8) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, small mammals, birds, humans | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerates air pollution

Flowers: raceme, striking, small, flower-scented | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** matt green, underside felty white | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow, red-brown | **Fruits:** edible, small, berry | **Fruit colour:** black-violet | **Bark colour:** brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** grey | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** shallow, highly branched
