Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, characteristic trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, small garden, ecological zone | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** open | **Height:** 5 - 8 m | **Width:** 3 - 4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, birds, nectar value 3, pollen value 3

Flowers: umbels, striking | **Flower colour:** cream-white | **Flowering period:** August - September | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, big, leaf thorns, bipinnate, composite | **Autumn colour:** yellow-orange, orange-red | **Fruits:** toxic, thorned, berry | **Fruit colour:** red, black | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** green | **Twigs:** thorned
