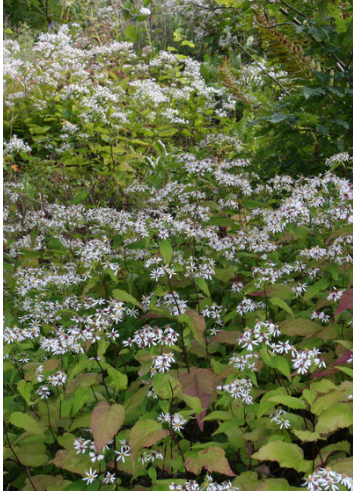


Aster divaricatus

TYPES OF PLANTING

Other types of planting: undergrowth, ground cover, perennials

USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none, open | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting, Eco planting, Landscape planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Height: 0.3 - 0.5 m | **Width:** 0.5 - 0.6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic (5.1 - 6.1) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: star-shaped | **Flower colour:** cream-white, yellow | **Flowering period:** July - September | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** lanceolate, narrow | **Autumn colour:** red-brown | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Twig colour:** brown | **Root system:** shallow, compact
