**Location:** park, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant

### CHARACTERISTICS

**Height:** 1 - 3 m | **Width:** 1 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 8A - 10B

### ASPECTS

**Wind:** intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 1, pollen value 1

**Flowers:** panicle, discrete | **Flower colour:** red | **Flowering period:** March - April | **Leaf colour:** variegated yellow, green | **Leaves:** evergreen, ovoid, serrate | **Fruits:** toxic | **Fruit colour:** red | **Twig colour:** green | **Twigs:** bare
