Tree types: standard trees, feathered trees, multi-stemmed trees

USE

Location: park, central reservation, roof garden, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 10 - 15 m | **Width:** 4 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** butterflies

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: catkins, pendulous | **Flower colour:** pale yellow | **Flowering period:** April - April | **Leaf colour:** dark green, buds bright green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, polished, rough, underside hairy, doubly serrate, dentate | **Autumn colour:** golden yellow | **Fruits:** striking, catkins | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** cream, red-brown, pale pink | **Bark:** peeling | **Twig colour:** brown-violet | **Twigs:** bare, pendulous, finely branched | **Root system:** shallow, extensive, slightly branched, many hair roots
