TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: solitary shrubs | **Other types of planting:** ground cover

USE

Location: park, central reservation, roof garden, large garden, small garden | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 0.8 - 1.2 m | **Width:** 0.8 - 1.2 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6B - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: raceme | **Flower colour:** yellow | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** dark green, underside blue-green | **Leaves:** evergreen, ovoid, polished, leaf thorns | **Fruits:** rarely fruits, berry | **Fruit colour:** blue-black | **Twig colour:** dark brown | **Twigs:** thorned
