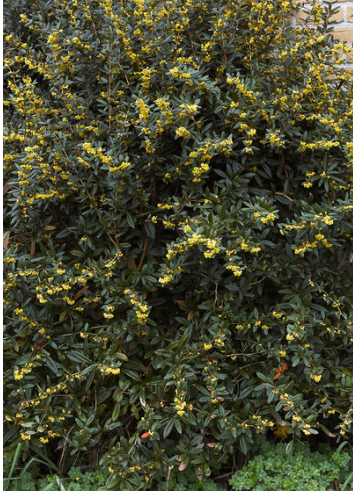


Berberis julianae

TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: woodland planting stock, solitary shrubs | **Other types of planting:** undergrowth, ground cover | **Topiary:** hedge

USE

Location: park, central reservation, roof garden, large garden, small garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 2 - 3 m | **Width:** 1.5 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: raceme | **Flower colour:** yellow | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** evergreen, lanceolate, leathery, prickly | **Autumn colour:** red | **Fruits:** small, berry | **Fruit colour:** blue | **Twig colour:** brown | **Twigs:** thorned
