USE

Location: park, central reservation, roof garden, large garden, small garden, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 1 - 1.5 m | **Width:** 1 - 1.5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 7B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

Flowers: raceme, pendulous | **Flower colour:** yellow | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** green, underside grey-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, obovate, leaf thorns | **Autumn colour:** red | **Fruits:** small, berry | **Fruit colour:** red | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** thorned
