Tree types: solitary shrubs | **Other types of planting:** undergrowth

USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, coastal area | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: flattened spherical | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 0.9 - 1.2 m | **Width:** 1.2 - 1.8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 7A - 9A

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

Flowers: corymbose, striking, pendulous, small | **Flower colour:** orange | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** blue-green | **Leaves:** evergreen, lanceolate, small, leathery, leaf thorns | **Fruits:** small, berry | **Fruit colour:** blue | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** grey-brown | **Twigs:** thorned
