Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral (5.6 - 7.5) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, nectar value 0, pollen value 1

Flowers: catkins, discrete | **Flower colour:** yellow-green | **Flowering period:** March - April | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, opposite, polished, dissected, serrate, lobate | **Autumn colour:** yellow, yellow-brown | **Fruits:** discrete, catkins | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** white, black | **Bark:** peeling, furrowed | **Twig colour:** black | **Twigs:** with lenticels, polished, pendulous | **Root system:** shallow, extensive, highly branched
