TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, feathered trees, multi-stemmed trees | **Topiary on stem:** espalier, pleached

USE

Location: avenue, park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none, open

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: egg-shaped, wide egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 10 - 15 m | **Width:** 6 - 10 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 7B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** butterflies | **Extreme environments:** not affected by infestations of lice

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: catkins, discrete, pendulous | **Flower colour:** golden yellow | **Flowering period:** April - April | **Leaf colour:** dark green, bronze-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, cordate, rough, dentate | **Autumn colour:** golden yellow | **Fruits:** discrete, catkins | **Fruit colour:** yellow-brown | **Bark colour:** white, cream | **Bark:** peeling | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** hairy, with lenticels, vertical branches, short shoots | **Root system:** deep, slightly branched
