Crown shape: vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 1 - 3 m | **Width:** 1 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 9A

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution
