USE

Location: park, small garden, patio, cemetery, ecological zone | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant, Eco planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Height: 0.3 - 0.5 m | **Width:** 0.5 - 0.7 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 3A - 7B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist, wet | **Light requirements:** partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral (5.6 - 7.5) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: raceme, corymbose, small | **Flower colour:** pale blue, blue | **Flowering period:** March - May | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, cordate, thick, rough, slightly hairy | **Autumn colour:** brown | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Twig colour:** pale green | **Root system:** deep, slightly branched
