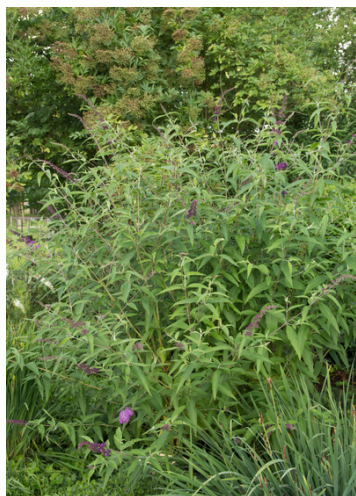


Buddleja davidii 'Ile de France'

Tree types: solitary shrubs

USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 2 - 2.5 m | **Width:** 1 - 2 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6B - 10B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, nectar value 2, pollen value 0

Flowers: panicle, striking, flower-scented | **Flower colour:** dark violet | **Flowering period:** July - September | **Leaf colour:** grey-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, lanceolate, big | **Fruits:** discrete, capsule | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** brown | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** brown
