Location: park, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** none, open | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 0.5 - 1 m | **Width:** 0.5 - 1 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 9B

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees
