Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, shade trees, solitary shrubs

USE

Location: park, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: flattened spherical | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 6 - 8 m | **Width:** 6 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6B - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 0, pollen value 3

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: panicle, trumpet-shaped, striking, big | **Flower colour:** white, violet | **Flowering period:** June - July | **Leaf colour:** buds yellow, yellow-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, cordate, big | **Autumn colour:** pale yellow | **Fruits:** striking, large, pod | **Fruit colour:** brown-green | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** peeling, slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** grey-brown | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** deep, coarse roots, fleshy roots, central root
