Location: park, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting, shade-tolerant

CHARACTERISTICS

Height: 2 - 3 m | **Width:** 1 - 2 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 4, pollen value 4
