TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, feathered trees | **Topiary on stem:** roof-trained

USE

Location: park, large garden, small garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: weeping, wide weeping | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 3 - 4 m | **Width:** 4 - 5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline

Flowering period: non-flowering | **Leaf colour:** bright green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, ovoid, doubly serrate | **Autumn colour:** pale yellow | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** grey-brown | **Twigs:** hairy, pendulous | **Root system:** deep, shallow, extensive, fine roots
