USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Planting concepts:** food forest

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown structure: semi-open | **Height:** 1 - 3 m | **Width:** 1 - 2 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: star-shaped, standing, flower-scented | **Flower colour:** red-brown | **Flowering period:** June - August | **Leaf colour:** green, underside grey-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, polished, underside hairy, scented with contusion | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** discrete | **Bark colour:** bronze-green | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** violet | **Twigs:** bare
