**Flowers:** star-shaped, striking, big, fruit scented | **Flower colour:** red-brown | **Flowering period:** June - August | **Leaf colour:** green, underside red, underside red-violet | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, opposite, densely hairy, scented with contusion | **Autumn colour:** violet | **Fruits:** discrete | **Bark colour:** bronze-green | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** violet | **Twigs:** bare
