TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, feathered trees, multi-stemmed trees, characteristic trees | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, large garden, small garden, cemetery, countryside | **Pavement:** none, open | **Planting concepts:** Landscape planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: ovoid | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 4 - 5 m | **Width:** 3 - 5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 10B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral

Flowers: catkins, discrete | **Flower colour:** yellow-green | **Flowering period:** March - March | **Leaf colour:** buds red, bright green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, slightly hairy, doubly serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** discrete, nut | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** hairy | **Root system:** shallow
