TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, half-stem trees, feathered trees, multi-stemmed trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Height: 3 - 6 m | **Width:** 1 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 7A - 10B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** partial shade | **pH range:** acidic | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: rosette-shaped, striking, big, scented | **Flower colour:** red | **Flowering period:** March - April | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** evergreen, ovoid, thick, leathery, polished, serrate | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** black | **Twigs:** slightly thorned
